## The House:

A spacious house built in 2004/2005 with around 120 m<sup>2</sup> of living space on the ground floor comprising :

A south-facing covered porch leading into the large living/dining room (36m<sup>2</sup>) with American style kitchen (12m<sup>2</sup>) and adjoining larder (4.5m<sup>2</sup>), all with tiled floor, two east-facing French windows and wood burning stove.

Also on the ground floor is a large west-facing master bedroom (16m<sup>2</sup>) with en-suite shower room (4.5m<sup>2</sup>) and en-suite dressing room (3.5m<sup>2</sup>); three smaller bedrooms (11m<sup>2</sup>, 11m<sup>2</sup>, 10m<sup>2</sup>), a large family bathroom with both full-sized bath and large shower, bidet and two washbasins (7.5m<sup>2</sup>) and a separate wc. All the bedrooms have laminated parquet floors and the bathrooms are tiled.

On the first floor is a large attic space of around 90 m<sup>2</sup>, and ceiling height of around 2m30, and which could be converted into extra living space.

The 1200 m<sup>2</sup> of surrounding grounds are partly enclosed and consist of lawn with a mix of mature trees, shrubs and flower beds and a front parking area for cars.
