A very pretty old farm, completely restored, dating from 1850 with around 200 m2 of living space on three levels, an old stone stable for restoration, an open fronted barn, a restored bread oven, all set on around 4 hectares of mostly wooded land between Salignac-Eyvigues and Souillac in the Dordogne.

Absolute peace and quiet for this little gem with no nuisance.

First floor :

About 50 meters behind the house is a small stone stable in need of restoration to provide around 20 m2 of usable space.

Just to the left on entering the property is a long open-fronted storage barn with around 100 m2 of usable space for storing house and garden equipment and tools.

The 4 hectares of grounds is mainly woodland but there is a large field to the west and north of the house.

Access to the property is via a long lane which only serves this property.
